Beginning Watercolor by Jane Krause-

October 12, Monday from 6pm to 8pm Jane will be instructing the basics for applying watercolor in layers, keeping the colors transparent. You will leave with one to two paintings. One of the paintings will show a technique for painting birch trees. All the paints, paper and brushes will be supplied. You do not need prior experience and do not need to bring anything. The fee for this class is \$20.

Watercolor Workshop with Roy Lowry-

October 19, Monday from 10am to 4pm Roy is back by popular demand to continue his instruction in basic watercolor painting. He is supplying all paper, paints and brushes and students do not need to bring anything. This class is for beginner/intermediate watercolor artists. Roy will lecture on color theory from 10am to 12pm. We will take a break for lunch from 12pm to 1pm. (Bring your own lunch or get lunch downtown.) From 1pm to 4pm you will be painting. The theme for this painting will be a winter scene. The fee for this workshop is \$45.

Beginning Knitting - Knitting a scarf by Christine Stansbery-

November 9, Monday from 6pm to 8pm Chris will be teaching casting on and basic knitting stitches making a long scarf with color changes and embellishing yarns. You will have a good start and be able to take it home to finish over a weekend. You need to bring circular needles 24 to 29 inches long in size 9 or 10. All the yarn will be provided. This will make a fun gift for someone or keep it for yourself. There is no fee for this class and you do not need prior knitting experience.

Fused Glass by Dixie Rogerson-

November 17, Tuesday 6pm to 8pm Dixie will be inspiring you to design your own Frank Lloyd Wright inspired hanging fused glass piece. It is 3" by 12" and you will have your choice of colors in your design. She will take your piece to her workshop to be fired and install a copper hanger. The pieces will be returned to the gallery for you to pick up. These will make beautiful gifts for Christmas. You do not need experience to complete this project and she will supply all the tools and glass to complete your glass piece. The fee for this class is \$45.
